Please read the below policies

Taking the ice is a demonstration of agreement to the below policies.

1. Skaters must be a current USFSA member to contract ice.
2. There are no deletions or substitutions to the contract.
3. Skaters must sign-in at the front desk before going on the ice. Skaters who have not signed in will be ask to leave the ice and return to the front desk to do so. Skaters continuously taking the ice prior to signing in at the desk will lose ice priviledges without refund or credit for any pre-paid ice.
4. Skaters must use assigned locker rooms to change skates and equipment. Skate bags must be in the locker room prior to taking the ice.
5. If a skater is unable to skate for 30 or more days due to any injury or illness; they may request that their contract be canceled until the skater can resume full skating activities. This request should be in writing to the skating director with a doctor's letter.
6. Absolutely no eating, drinking or gum chewing on the ice with the exception of plastic or metal water bottles.
7. Proper respect must be shown to all professionals, monitors, instructors, fellow skaters and parents. All skaters and parents must adhere to the skater and parent code of conduct set forth by USFS and NEFSC. Repeated or serious infractions of the rules will result in loss of ice privileges. Foul language or show of temper is not allowed, and the skater will be asked to leave the ice.
8. Ice sessions are for training purposes for figure skaters.
9. John Lindell Ice Arena reserves the right to cancel scheduled events without liability, other than reimbursement credit.
10. The John Lindell Ice Arena shall not be liable for any and all claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages or losses of any kind to persons or property which may be sustained in connection with any John Lindell Ice Arena activity.
11. Recognizing the normal risk of skating on ice, I agree to skate at my own risk and to abide by all skating policies established by the John Lindell Ice Arena management and/or professionals. The John Lindell Ice Arena assumes no responsibility for accidents on or off the ice, or damage to personal property.
